- When is a claim necessary (depending on doctors' enrollment in Medicare) – assignment vs. contractual vs. no involvement at all – and how to get the form and how to fill it out.
- Dealing with denials for Part A, Part B, Part D and supplemental: how to determine what is denied and why from Medicare and from a supplemental policy, the various appeals processes (cite cases).
- The most common mistakes a client can make in using the system so that the system does not use the client.
